Wind: two contrasting pieces, or two movements from a solo sonata or concerto.

PLEASE NOTE: Final applicants will perform selections in front of a panel of judges at an audience event. Finalists will be notified via mail and advised of specific details regarding performance dates, venue, time, etc.
